More people in Latin America and the Caribbean are connected to the Internet than ever. Latin America seems to be in an accelerated path toward digitization in a post pandemic era. New technologies can be seen all across the social sciences, in media, journalism, education, and government. Nevertheless, going digital poses many challenges for the region and could even amplify other inequalities, including an increased technological divide, lack of access in rural areas, and the non-inclusion of the informal sector. In the job market, for example, very few workers have proficiency in the use of digital tools and a large share of adults have little or no computer experience. Hence, a digital transformation in Latin America could be an opportunity to not only address inequalities, corruption, and weak governance, but also to spur sustainability and innovation. In this SSLAS, we hope to take a closer look at digital cultures and cultural production, including new media, and electronic art and literature. We will also analyze the present and future of e-journalism as well as inquire how digital technologies can influence government institutions and democracies. Additionally, we will ask how new technologies are used in farming, the mining industry, or to combat child vulnerabilities.
